


the students who were enthusiastic to be back on campus.



Two students from DPS Budgam, Sakhra Riyaz and Rahil Nabi, received full-ride scholarships to universities in Qatar and the United States of America. Rahil Nabi was offered admission with a full scholarship to Georgetown University in Washington, DC. He also received an
