DPS BUDGAM ORGANISES PRESENTATION CUM INTERACTIVE SESSION ON CYBER CRIMES



With the increase in online activities and the mushrooming of social media sites, every individual is vulnerable to cyber crimes. We are not safe in our own houses, as organised criminals are out to steal our data, rob us of our money, ruin our reputation, morph our pictures, cause us mental stress, send unwanted messages, etc. In this context, with the intention of spreading awareness among young minds and sensitizing them about the risks involved in online activities, DPS Budgam organized an awareness camp for its students. Mr. Sujeet Kumar, DIG Central Range ([&K Police), was the chief

guest of the programme. Ms. Syed Sleet Shah, Deputy SP Crime (J&K Police), was the guest of honour. The session began with the introduction of the topic by the students of Class 11th. It was followed by a detailed presentation by Ms. Syed Sleet Shah. She enlightened the gathering about the risks involved in forwarding a simple message without verifying its credentials. Mr. Sujit Kumar spoke about 'Cyber Security'. He discussed fake accounts and how criminals dupe thousands of people by impersonating someone else. It was further indicated that the present day youth are both victims and accused of cyber-crimes. Mr. Kumar listed the ways in which we can protect our profiles and save ourselves from cyber criminals. He further spoke about cyber engineering and how our complete behaviour and likes and









dislikes are being monitored and stored in databases. Furthermore, Inspector Reyaz (J&K Police) also interacted with the students. He gave examples of how common people in Kashmir were duped of money. He also made the audience aware of the law in place for such crimes. Throughout the session, students asked questions, and the guests were more than happy to answer them. The principal Ms. Shobhna Sirohi stressed on the risks involved in using the Internet without proper guidance and monitoring by elders. The session concluded with a cultural programme by the students.

URDU/ HINDI DEBATE FOR CLASS **5TH**

MEMORIAL LECTURE ON THE LEGENDARY POET 'MEHJOOR' ORGANISED BY THE SCHOOL



A Memorial Lecture was organised by DPS Budgam to commemorate the Shair-e-Kashmir-Peerzada Ghulam Ahmad Mehjoor. The lecture was presented by the famous poet and scholar, Mr. Abdul Mehjoor, the grandson of Peerzada Ghulam



Ahmad Mehjoor. The event was presided over by the eminent educationist, Prof. Neerja Mattoo while the Pro VC DPS Budgam, Mrs. Mumtazunnisa Soz further graced the occasion with her benign presence. A documentary highlighting the life of Mehjoor and a special musical programme based on Mehjoor's poetry presented by the Music Department. of the School. Mr. Abdal Mehjoor, in his lecture, highlighted that Mehjoor introduced a new style into Kashmiri poetry and expanded it into previously unexplored thematic realms. He is the most known and sung poet of Kashmir. Mr. Abdal Mehjoor stressed that undoubtedly like Wordsworth, Mehjoor's gazals and nazms soothed, healed and inspired miserable Kashmiris especially those belonging to the lower rung in society like meagerly paid labourers and

hardworking farmers. Professor Neerja Mattoo expressed her delight to see the school taking such keen efforts to link the present generation to their past. She explained to the students that Mehjoor, the man of sensitive tendencies brought forth his higher concepts and sent valuable messages of love, patriotism, mutual respect, values and purpose of life to the world. He gave a message of Hindu-Muslim brotherhood through the values he inculcated in his poetry. The principal, Ms. Shobhna Sirohi while presenting the vote of thanks stressed the need of safeguarding the rich culture and tradition of the land. She further stressed the need for realising the lessons of introspection and living with dignity that the great poet has taught us.

MATHS OLYMPIAD

An Olympiad helps students analyse their strengths and weaknesses based on their performance in the competition. To assess students' mathematical abilities, an Olympiad was organised for the students of Class 3 by the Mathematics department of the Junior Wing. The objective of this Olympiad was to establish in students a competitive attitude. The Olympiad was conducted in two phases. In the first phase, a paper based test was conducted. Based on their performance in Phase-I test, the 12 top performing students got selected for the Phase II. Phase II included four rounds. In Round 1 namely Playing with Numbers',12 questions were asked in aggregate, one to each participant. In Round 2 namely Rapid Fire, each student had to answer questions in the time span of 30 seconds which ended up



by eliminating 6 participants in the end. In the Round 3 namely *Knocker Round*, the student who raised the placard first was given a chance to answer, which ended up proclaiming the top three winners of the Mathematics Olympiad. **Mohammad Amaan Ibrahim 3F**, bagged the first position while **Musa Altaf 3A**, acquired the second position. There was a tie for the 3rd place between **Syed Noor ul Ain 3E** and **Nyla Nisar 3F**. The students expressed their talents by enthusiastically competing in the Olympiad.

first round, namely Playing with Numbers, two questions were posed to each team and the time limit for answering each question was 1 minute followed by Rapid Fire Round, the second round, thereupon. 4 teams advanced to the third round after promptly answering questions in the duration of 1 minute. In 3rd round, two questions were asked of each team, eventually knocking out one more team. In the last round, 'Wait Think and Answer', three teams - A, D and F competed against each other wherein Team F secured its position at top leaving behind Team A and Team D as first and second runner ups respectively. The fervent participants gave a tough battle to each other in all four rounds and showcased their brilliance by rapidly answering the questions.
